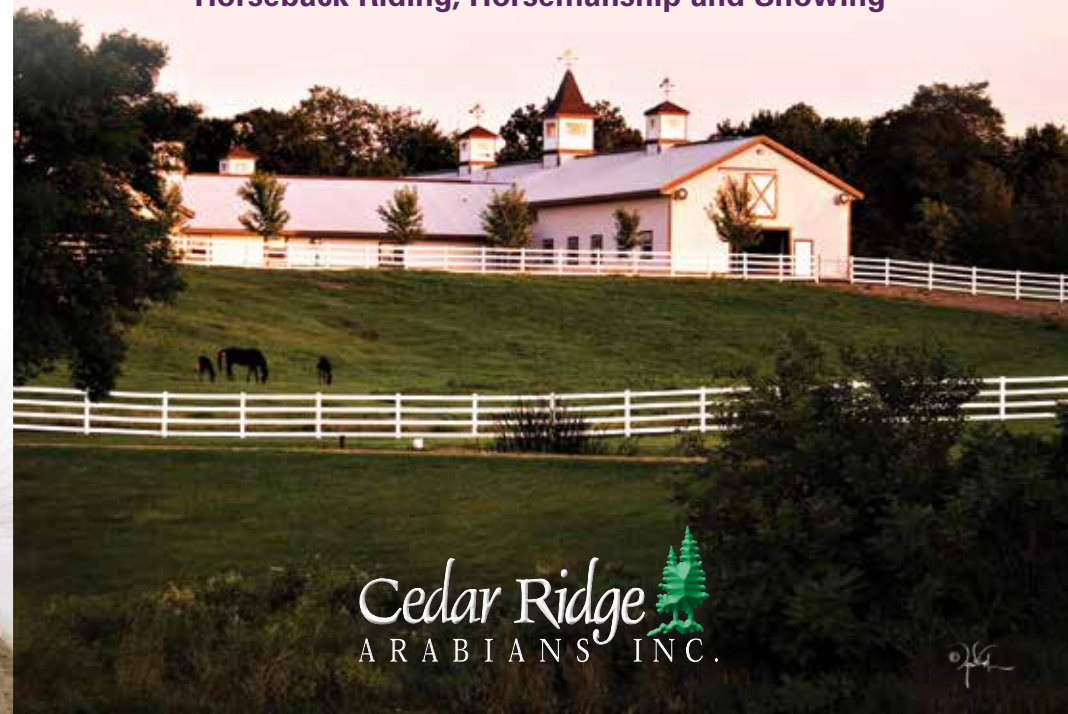

Riding Lessons

Lessons at CRRC are taught by instructor Stephanie Davisson, who brings with her a love and passion for the Arabian horse, along with nearly a decade of instruction experience helping riders achieve their ultimate goals.

Lessons are an hour long and include time spent both tacking and untacking your horse, with the help of an instructor. In a typical lesson, the rider will spend 15 minutes tacking, 30 minutes riding and 10-15 minutes untacking. Lessons are held year-round with an indoor heated arena for comfort and convenience in the winter months.

At CRRC, we encourage our riders to participate in our in-house "Fun Show" and progress through the stages of becoming a competitive rider.



Stages of Showing

- **Cedar Ridge Arabians In-House "Fun Show"** — A fun introduction to horse shows for the beginning student, or a practice show for more experienced riders. Available only to Cedar Ridge customers.
- **Academy Shows** — A beginners level of showing for riders from many different barns. These academy classes are often held at Class A shows to gain the experience of competing at a larger horse show, but enabling you to continue competing against other beginning riders.
- **Class "A" Shows** — Locally competitive shows give you the opportunity to compete in a larger, more competitive field.
- **Cedar Ridge Arabians Training Program** — As you progress through the Class A shows, we encourage you to become more involved with and look into the option of leasing, or even purchasing a horse to show at higher levels, including regionally and nationally.
